## M&D Builds New Storm Shelter at Steelcase plant in Athens

In the early spring of 2016, M&D Mechanical began working on new storm shelter structures at the Steelcase plant in Athens, Alabama. With a desire to create a safe environment for their employees during severe weather, the national furnishings manufacturer added two shelters at opposite ends of their existing facility totaling 7,000 square feet. M&D provided and installed the conditioned air HVAC systems, as well as full domestic water service and plumbing specialties for each space. One unique design feature of the shelters called for a large quantity of storm rated exterior louvers and dampers. This allows for fresh air and ventilation in the event of power loss at the Steelcase site. M&D worked closely with the owner and general

contractor to insure a quality outcome for the project that was on schedule and within budget.



## **M&D Installs New Cooling Tower at Helen Keller Hospital**

We recently installed a new 1000 ton Cooling Tower at Helen Keller Hospital in Sheffield. This project allows back-up for an older, existing cooling tower, and the ability to alternate chillers and towers for maintenance operations. The installation of new 16" underground condenser water lines to the new cooling tower sets the path for future expansion to meet the hospital's expected expansion requirements.
